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## **Family Orientation Contract**

At Phoenix Recovery Programs, we believe that families are the most important source of support for our clients. Addiction is a family disease that affects all members of the family physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Family involvement is an essential part of the recovery process.

Since the family is such an important element, we ask that family members be involved in our program in the following ways:

- Participate in our weekly Family Group. Family Group will be held on Wednesday evenings from 4:45 pm – 5:45 pm.
- Attend at least one community based Al-Anon meeting weekly and provide verification.
- Remain abstinent from all mood-altering chemicals for the duration for your child's treatment. We ask you to remain abstinent for several reasons. First, remaining abstinent is a method for parents to support the abstinence of their teenager. Secondly, parents may experience what their child will go through when saying no to the offer of a drink, joint, etc. This may also be a time for parents to re-evaluate and educate themselves about personal attitudes towards the use of chemicals in their life.
- Phoenix Recovery Programs reserves the right to request urine drug screens for any family members suspected of substance use or are under the influence. Failure to comply would result in being asked to leave the facility until such time you are willing to submit to testing. This is not meant to violate anyone's personal rights but to make sure that the safety and integrity of the program are maintained.

We wish you every success as you begin a program of recovery with your adolescent. Our hope is that your family will have every chance for success in our program.
